

Domestic Abuse Awareness

Course Description: To define, recognise and respond effectively to domestic abuse. This course pays particular attention to safeguarding children.

Target Group: Aimed at all staff working in settings who may be in contact with children, young people and/or parents/carers who may become aware of possible abuse or neglect

Training Level: All levels - additional awareness training

Pre-Requisite Learning: We recommend delegates complete child protection training at Level 1 before attending this course

Aims/Objectives:

- Define domestic abuse within a local and national context
- Be familiar with the prevalence of domestic abuse
- Understand the impact on non-abusing parents and how best to help and support them
- Understand the impact on children and how best to help and support them

Course Type: Classroom

Length of Course: 1 day

Valid for: One off training. Can be repeated as required
