

# Radicalisation

**Course Description:** This course is an introduction to the process of radicalisation and how to respond when concerns arise. It has been designed to provide participants with awareness and understanding of contexts, meanings, indicators and risk factors to effectively contribute to safeguarding children in relation to radicalisation. The course aims to increase practitioner's knowledge and confidence in identifying children and their families who are being radicalised, or at risk of radicalisation. A range of interventions will be explored within the local and national context.

**Target Group:** All staff who may be in contact with children, young people and/or parents/carers who may become aware of possible abuse, neglect or radicalisation. Aimed at individuals and teams with a direct role in working with young people (individually or in a group setting)

**Training Level:** All levels - additional awareness training

**Pre-Requisite Learning:** We recommend delegates complete child protection training at Level 1 before attending this course

## **Aims/Objectives:**

- Gain a deeper knowledge of radicalisation and recognise the increased risk for children who may be at risk
- Understand what extremism and radicalisation are and why it is important to discuss and address
- Have an understanding of the key extremist groups within the UK and worldwide and explore the local picture
- Know the main elements of the Prevent strand of the government's CONTEST strategy
- Better understand what makes people vulnerable to radicalisation and how children become involved in and react to exploitative situations
- Explore the journey which young people will experience when being radicalised, identifying the key stages for intervention
- Explore the types of intervention that can be considered by professionals when working with young people and their families
- Understand practitioner responsibilities and recognise indicators of radicalisation

**Course Type:** Classroom

**Length of Course:** ½ day

**Valid for:** One off training. Can be repeated as required
